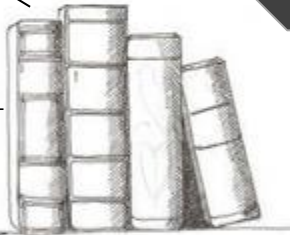

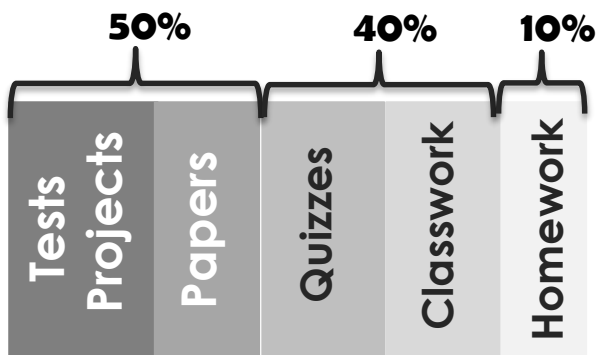

- obtain and complete all work missed due to absences.

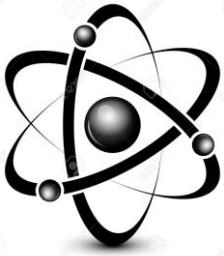
Daily assignments will be posted on the class website and available to download as a PDF.
